Innovation management and standardization at the Nuremberg Innovation Congress



The Nuremberg Innovation Congress will showcase the right approaches to successful innovation management on Monday, November 3, at the Nuremberg Exhibition Centre. Innovations are the key to long-term success and can help companies adapt to changing market conditions and remain competitive. Often, the ideas already exist within the company; they just need to be discovered, promoted, managed, and translated into market success.

Nuremberg – The Nuremberg Innovation Congress will take place on Monday, November 3, at the Nuremberg Exhibition Centre and will focus on the topics of innovation promotion and innovation management.
